

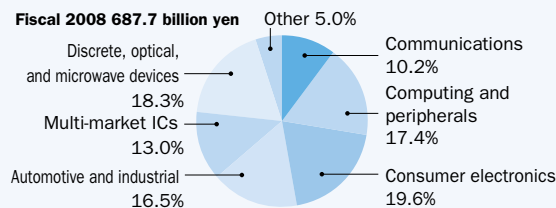

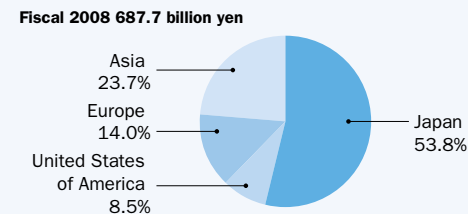
Trend in consolidated sales
